

Immigration – Informations sur la visite de la Statue de la liberté et du musée d'Ellis Island

Ellis Island Immigration Museum and the Statue of Liberty National Monument

Open all year except Christmas Day.
Call 212-363-3200 for specific hours.
Reservations required for school groups.

Take a full day out for your visit.
There is a café for drinks and snacks.
If you wish to visit both islands on one day, plan to take an early
ferry.
To take photos of the Statue of Liberty and Manhattan from the
ferry, wear a waterproof jacket it's often cold and windy in the bay.
The cost of the ferry is \$5 round trip.
Entrance to the Statue of Liberty and the Ellis Island Immigration
Museum is free.
No pets are allowed other than service dogs.
No eating, drinking, smoking, or chewing gum.
No skating or skateboarding.
Weapons are prohibited.
School groups must have one adult for every ten students.
All visitor facilities are accessible to persons with disabilities.
